ZEITFORM	OHNE FRAGEWORT
Simple present	Am / Is / Are + Subj. + ... <i>Are you from Germany?</i>
	Do / Does + Subj. + verb <i>Do you come from Germany?</i>
Present progressive	Am / Is / Are + Subj. + verb + ing <i>Are you sleeping?</i>
Simple past	Was / Were + Subj. + ... <i>Were they with their mother?</i>
	Did + Subj. + verb <i>Did you go to school today?</i>
Past progressive	Was / Were + Subj. + verb + ing <i>Were you eating?</i>
Present perfect	Has / Have + Subj. + past participle (verb) <i>Has she ever been there?</i>

Simple present	Fragewort + am / is / are + Subj. + ... <i>Where are you today?</i>
	Fragewort + do / does + Subj. + verb <i>What do you usually do?</i>
Present progressive	Fragewort + am / is / are + Subj. + verb + ing <i>When are you arriving?</i>
Simple past	Fragewort + was / were + Subj. + ... <i>Where were they yesterday?</i>
	Fragewort + did + Subj. + verb <i>How did you do it?</i>
Past progressive	Fragewort + was / were + Subj. + verb + ing <i>How was he doing?</i>
Present perfect	Fragewort + has / have + Subj. + past participle (verb) <i>How long has he been away?</i>
